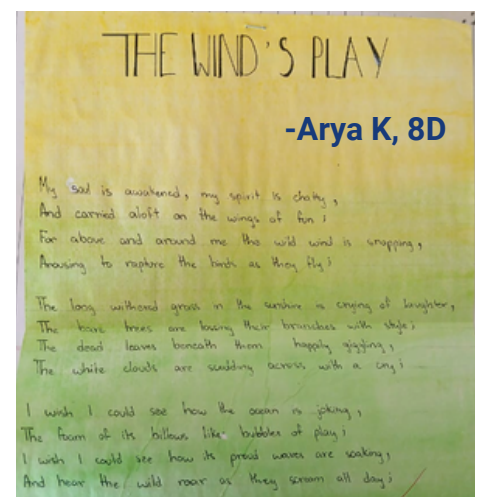
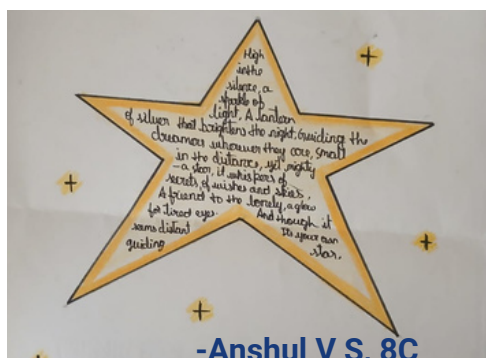
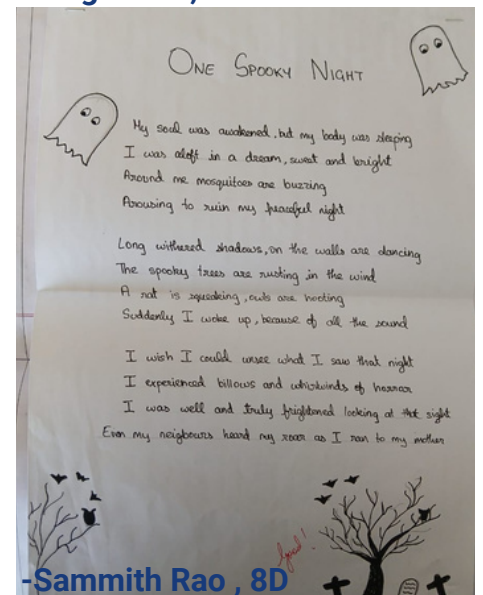
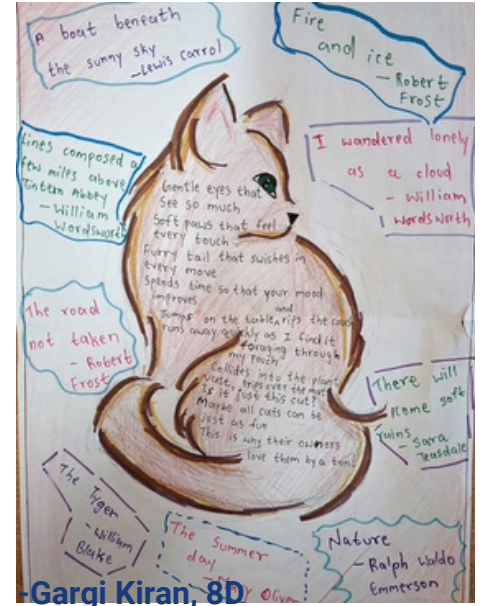
# THE FREEDOMITE
