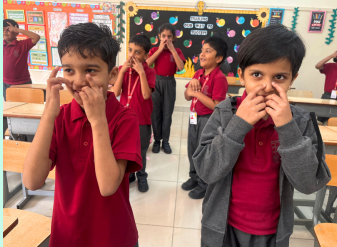
The occasion reflected the spirit of unity, gratitude, and commitment as FIS proudly stepped into the third decade of excellence in education and holistic development.

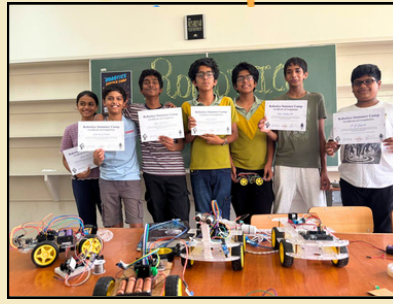
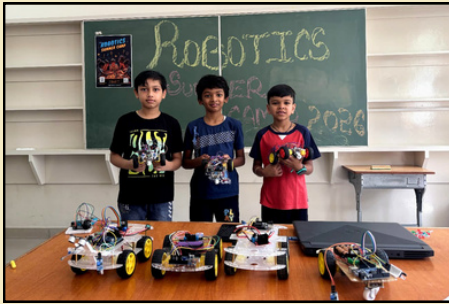
